2023JCSPO1	<p><b>2023 DEIS Seminar – Transitions and Attainment Spring</b></p> <p>This seminar specifically focuses on the DEIS themes of transitions and attainment. The seminar provides Principals, Deputy Principals, DEIS Coordinators and teachers an opportunity to engage in DEIS Action Planning through the six-step process. The focus of this seminar is on the themes of transitions and attainment, themes identified as areas of concern for some schools PDST advisors engaged with.</p> <p>This face to face seminar (limited to 2 teachers per school) will allow participants to explore in depth the themes of both transitions and attainment within their broader context. Participants will consider the areas of inclusivity and teacher and school level expectations of students and the subsequent role these expectations play within the themes of Transitions and Attainment.</p> <p>Consideration will be given to how effective Teaching, Learning and Assessment is the core activity for engineering change in schools. Participants will be afforded the time to collaborate and share their most effective teaching and learning practices which support students' transitions and attainment in the DEIS context. Participants will reflect on how the student, parent and teacher voice can support the implementation of the DEIS Action plan. Participants will be afforded the space to discuss the next steps for devising the DEIS Action plan through effective monitoring and evaluating of Targets and Actions.</p> <p>Consideration will also be given to the impact COVID 19 has had on planning for transitions and attainment, within both target setting and associated actions.</p> <p>Schools that are new to DEIS will be invited to this seminar. Throughout the seminar, the facilitator will use key slides to focus in on the basics of DEIS action planning for transition and attainment, asking more established Principals and DEIS Coordinators to share good practice.
