Collaborative Profiling Excel sheet

A copy of the "JCSP COLLABORATIVE PROFILING 2025-2026 Excel sheet" can be downloaded from the homepage of www.jcsp.ie. It is offered as an approach to help Coordinators collect JCSP student data within their school. Initially, you will need to download it, save it to your school platform before sharing it with teachers in your school. Each sheet will be a complete record for an academic year containing three tabs, one 2nd and 3rd year. Subject to Coordinator feedback and any amendments to be made, a new sheet issues each year.

Free Membership of the Oide JCSP Library Project Digital Library

Membership of the JCSP Library Project Digital Library is free to all JCSP and (pre- 2022) DEIS schools.

Existing member schools have received an updated set of Digital Library logins which includes a set of logins for incoming 1st Year students.

Eligible non-member schools can register at this link: https://jcsplibraries.com/jcsp-digital-library/ following which you will be provided with details on how to complete the registration process.





The library contains over 15,000 unique e-book and e-audiobook titles (with multiple copies of many of these bringing the overall total to over 77,000 titles) together with a selection of over 970 (always available) Digital Magazine titles. There are over 100,000 individual students and 9,000 staff from over 230 schools using the library. As new titles are being added continuously, all schools are encouraged to use this fantastic free library service.

Ordering Resources – 4 orders per year without mailing/delivery costs

Orders are placed through our distributor, Codex, www.codex.ie, by the JCSP Coordinator (login and password required). Please complete the GDPR form 2025/2026 Register for JCSP services so that a new account can be created for you. We will use the student numbers in your school as of the end of the last school year to establish a base line for ordering resources.

There is no charge for JCSP resources for JCSP students. Four orders will be provided to schools during the 2025/2026 academic year (in addition to the ordering of initiative materials) at no cost. However, additional orders will incur a delivery cost of €30.
